

## **The charter of the appeal**

- 1- This appeal, entitled 'A European appeal to resist financial dictatorship', may be signed by anyone aged sixteen or over. Signatories must indicate first and last names and city and country of residence; indication of profession is optional. An e-mail address is required to confirm the signature; it will remain confidential.
- 2- This appeal is intended for circulation in the local, regional and national media, print or electronic, of all European countries. The translations of this appeal must be as faithful as possible to the original text. Only the French and English versions released on the Mediapart website have genuine validity.
- 3- This appeal is based on citizen participation, with no association or link to political parties or ideologies. Well-known signatories, whatever their moral or scientific authority, will not be listed separately or otherwise distinguished. The value of this appeal derives uniquely from the expression of citizens on a free and equal basis. There will be a separate section for group signatures, reserved for associations, trade-unions and political parties.
- 4- Mediapart is the unique website host of this appeal which will appear on the main page of the Readers' Club, in the French edition as well as the English one. Mediapart has agreed to bring technical and IT support to this appeal.
- 5- On the website, the number of signatures will be clearly indicated and available to anyone at any time. In the event that Mediapart comes to an agreement with a foreign media organization to make the appeal available for signature on another site, the number of signatures will remain under the control of Mediapart in coordination with the editorial board of the foreign media organization which will certify the accuracy of its own count.
